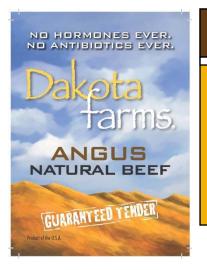




North Dakota State Legislature created the ND Beef Systems Center of Excellence

- North Dakota State University designated as executor of \$800,000 in appropriated funding
- Requirements to access funding
 - \$1,000,000 Federal participation
 - NDSU applied for and received \$1,000,000 USDA grant
 - \$1,000,000 private entity participation
 - North Dakota Natural Beef (NDNB) formed in 2005 by North American Bison Cooperative (NABC) as the private entity participator





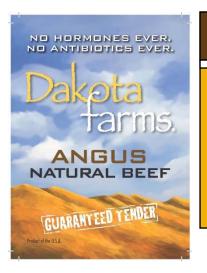
Objective: Reduced cost structure and create synergistic effort.

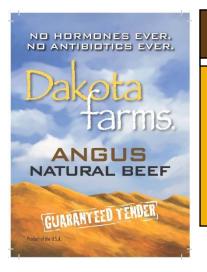

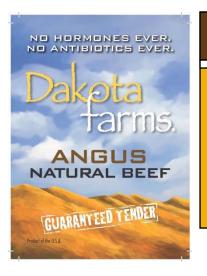
- Existing faculty and new faculty funded through Beef Systems Center of Excellence to develop a nationally recognized meat science department

- The first of its kind relationship in agriculture

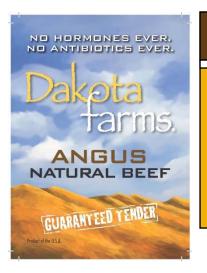

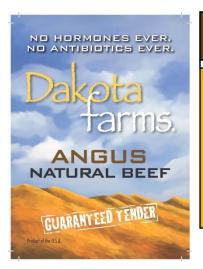

- 3rd party audit of the facilities to ensure it meets the highest standards





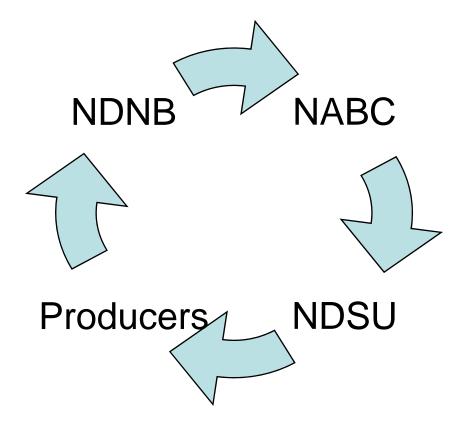

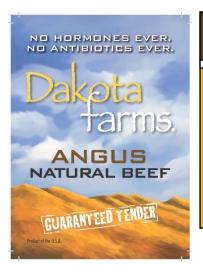

 - NDSU Leased Space

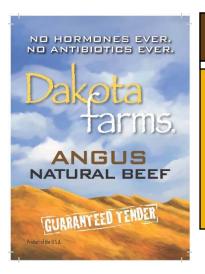


North Dakota Natural Beef Facility – August 2007



North Dakota Natural Beef Facility – August 2008

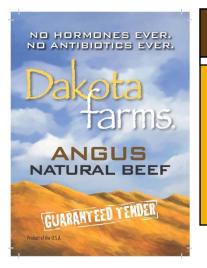




Natural Beef Market

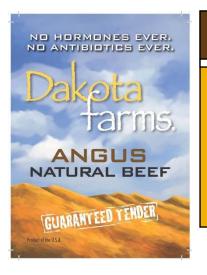
- Unequaled strategic alliance with a major land grant university: North Dakota State University

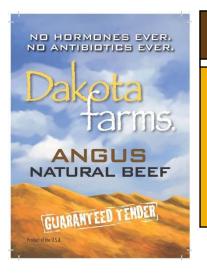

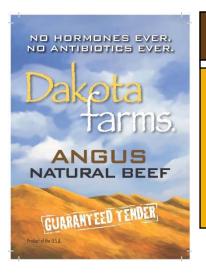

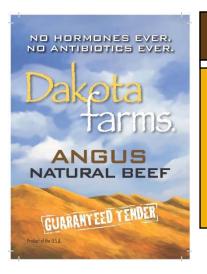


Animal Specifications

Never-Ever Hormone & Never-Ever Antibiotic Specifications

- Supplemental hormones of any kind in the feed or via implant have never been used
- Beta-agonists have never been used
- Antibiotics including ionophores, either therapeutic or sub therapeutic have never been used





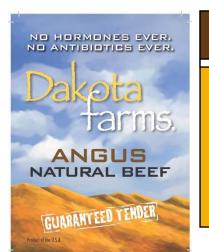
Animal Specifications

Age & Origin

- 24 months of age or younger at the time of harvest
- United States Origin only Product of USA

Breeding

- Angus Black or Red Angus
- Genetics of Bos Taurus cattle are used exclusively
- Animals are sourced from the North Dakota region



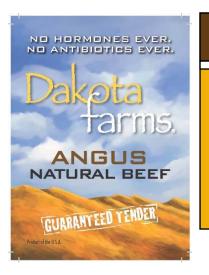

Animal Specifications

Feeding Regimen

- □ Fed for at least 100 days before harvest
- Grain ration comprised of no less than 50% grain
- No animal by-products, vegetarian fed
- Feedstuffs have not come into contact with any hormones or antibiotics (including ionophores)
- High level of Vitamin E in ration

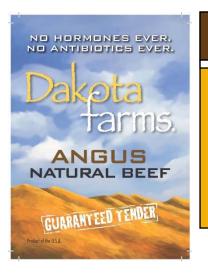
USDA Grading

 Animals are USDA graded to maximize producer and company profitability for high quality cattle

Affidavit & Audit Monitoring

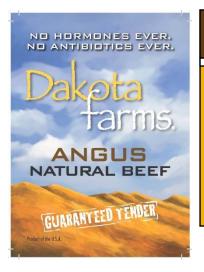
- Affidavits must be signed by cow/calf producer, stocker, backgrounder and feeder
- NDNB & 3rd Party Auditors perform random unannounced audits of the supply chain





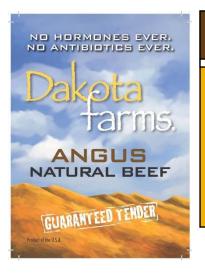
Grading and Pricing Policy

- General Pricing: Base Price + Never-Ever
 Premium+/- Premiums/Discounts for USDA grade
- Paid on a Hot Carcass Weight (HCW) basis
- Premium of \$75-\$150 per animal depending upon animal grade
- NDNB Program Animal Grade Objective: USDA Choice & USDA Prime



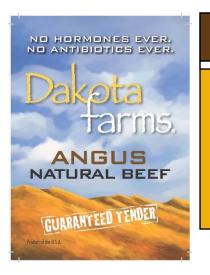
Producer Benefits

- Premium for Never-Ever Animals
- Shipping Advantage
- North Dakota Economic Benefit
 - For every \$1.00 spent on beef in North Dakota, the return is in excess of \$4.00 in the economy of the State of North Dakota



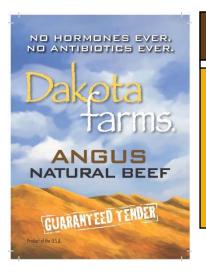
Animal Needs

- North Dakota Natural Beef is expanding their customer base – anticipate an additional 200 animals/week within a month
- As NDNB grows, more and more animals are needed
- NDNB sources animals from the ND region

- Deliver as scheduled



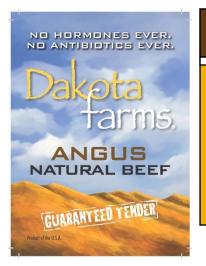

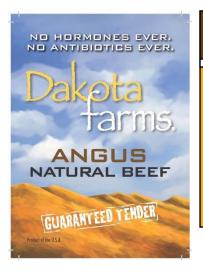
