

## Did you know?

- ◆ More than 80% of our graduates are *employed* within three months after graduation.
- ◆ Each year the College awards *scholarships* to over one-fourth of our students.
- ◆ The College offers programs that open doors to *exciting opportunities* in the expanding realm of agriculture. Interdisciplinary programs such as biotechnology, equine studies, sports and urban turfgrass management, food science, food safety, natural resource management, and agribusiness have been developed in response to emerging needs within the field of agriculture.
- ◆ With the student-faculty ratio of 11 to 1, students receive *individualized attention* from faculty who are intimately involved in the region's agriculture.
- ◆ The College is located in an urban agricultural center with close proximity to both production agriculture and processing. This provides unique and marketable "hands-on" experience for students involved in *research projects* and *industry internships*.
