Trainers

These are long days but the timing is necessary to cover all the material. Participants **must** be present for the entire training to become licensed to facilitate the program.

Registration Cost

The customary registration fee of \$300 is being waived due to a new grant through the North Dakota Department of Human Services, Aging Services Division. In addition, participants will be eligible to be reimbursed for mileage, lodging, and meals to attend the Class Leader training.

Training Partners

It is a requirement that the PTC program be co-led, so you will need to consider who would be available and willing to be a teaching partner with you. Co-leaders can be professionals in areas such as health care, social work, aging, and community education. However, it is not required co-leaders have a professional background. Requirements to become a class leader include: 1) have group facilitation skills; 2) have a sponsoring organization; 3) have experience working with family caregivers, and 4) agree to the expectations of the PTC program.
