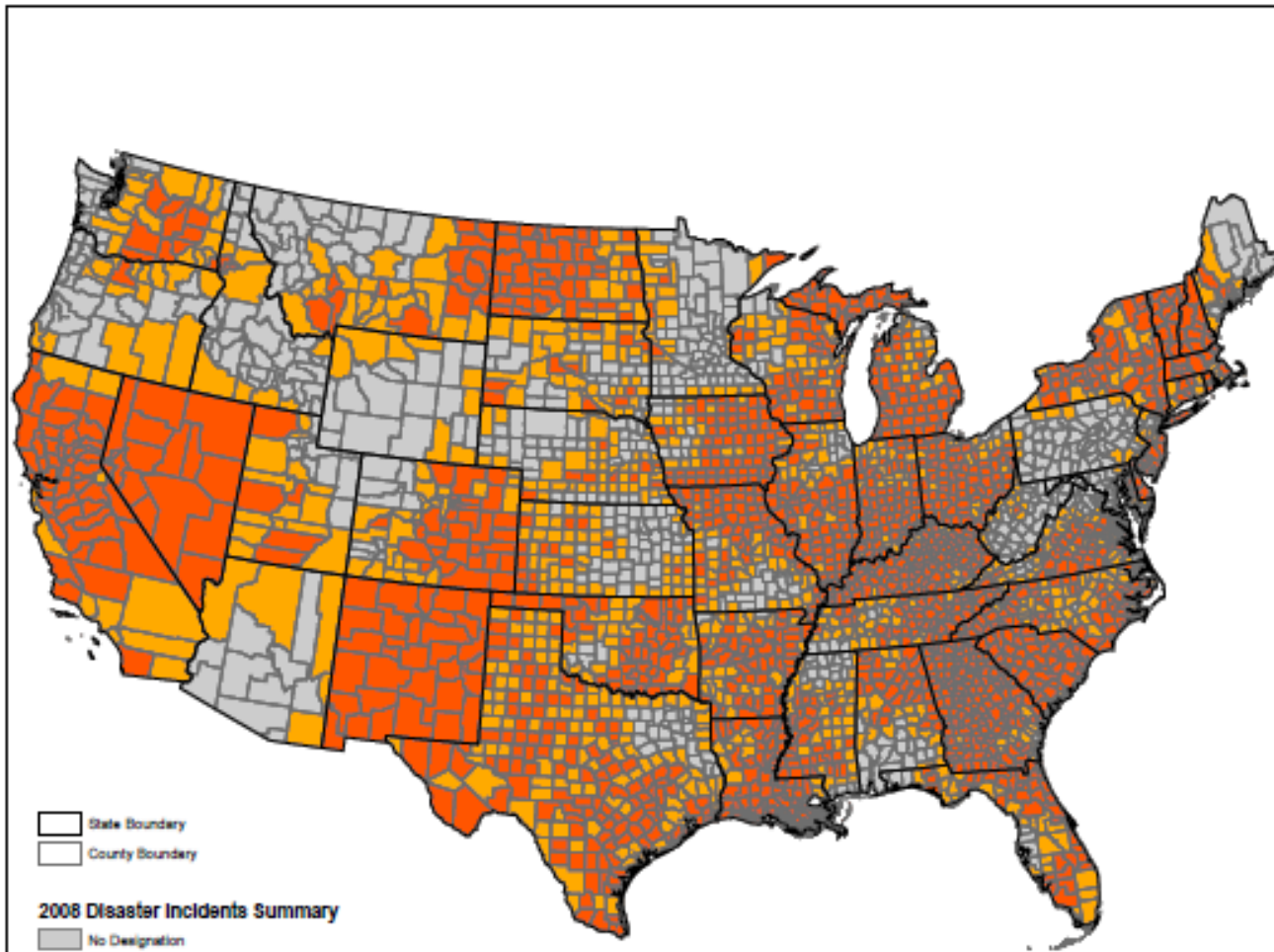


# SURE

- **2008**
  - Signup for 2008 SURE ends Sept. 30, 2010
  - Final N.D. payout will be 250 to 300 million
    - Drought in West
    - Drop from high beginning prices (i.e. wheat \$11.11, soybean \$13.36)
- **2009**
  - Signup for 2009 will start around Dec. 2010
  - Payout due to corn?
- **2010**
  - Payout not likely because of good yields, lower beginning prices, and possibly less “disaster” counties
- **2011?**
- **2012** (no, not funded)

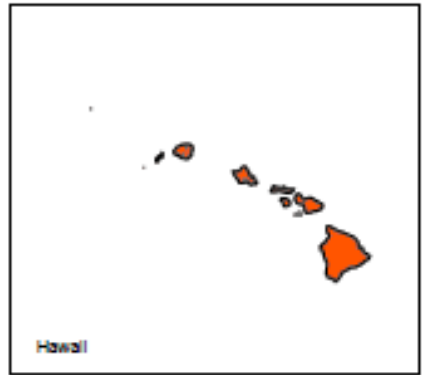

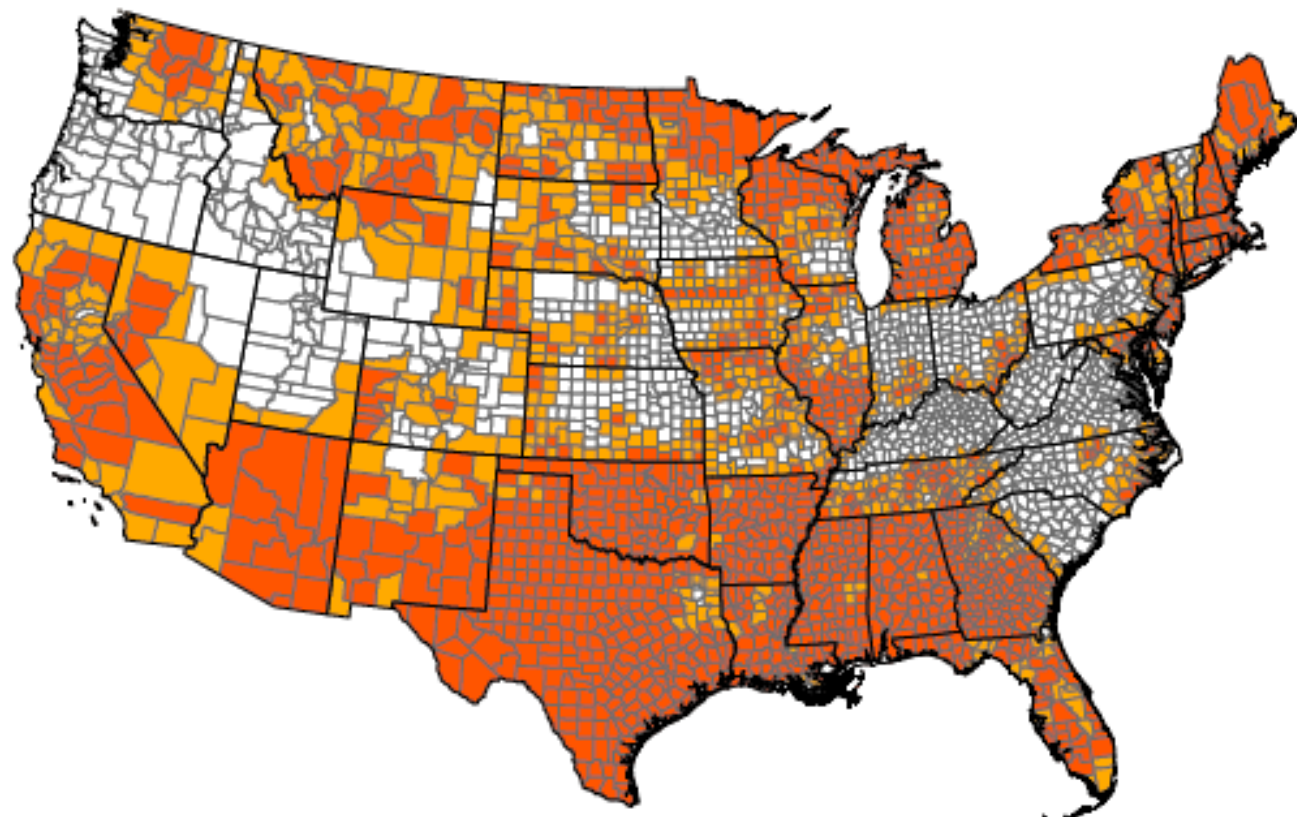

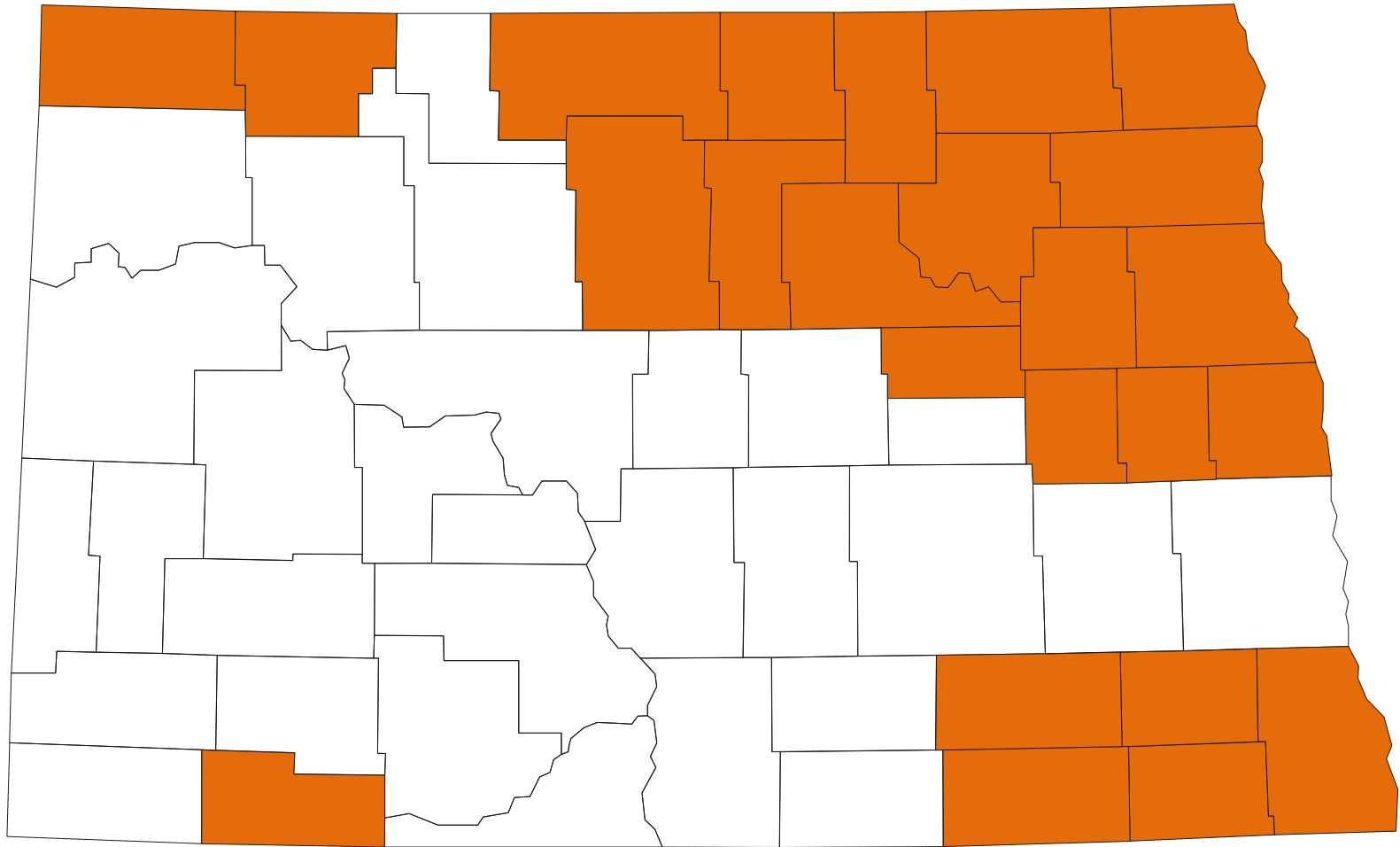

# 2009 Ad Hoc Disaster Aid

(AKA Blanche Lincoln assistance)

- Limited to cotton, rice, soybean and sweet potatoes
- Limited to disaster counties. It does not include adjacent counties.
- Signup probably starts in October
- Signup by FSA farm visit
- Producer must sign that they had yield loss greater than 5 percent to get a fixed per acre payment

# OTHER FUNDING

## Durum Quality Initiative

- 50 percent cost share for fusarium head blight fungicide and application
- Maximum payout:
  - \$7/acre for fungicide
  - \$3/acre for application
- Signup deadline was Sept. 15, 2010
- Total funding is capped at \$3 million, nationwide
- Payout will be pro-rated if signup exceeds total funding
