Landscape Forest Stewardship planning brings together groups of stakeholders to strengthen collaborative and large-scale planning around a priority forest resource to advance a key strategies identified in the North Dakota Forest Action Plan. The intent is to provide guidance and best management recommendations to encourage and enable active, long-term forest management across multiple land ownerships to meet individual and collective goals and for the benefit of the forest resource.
