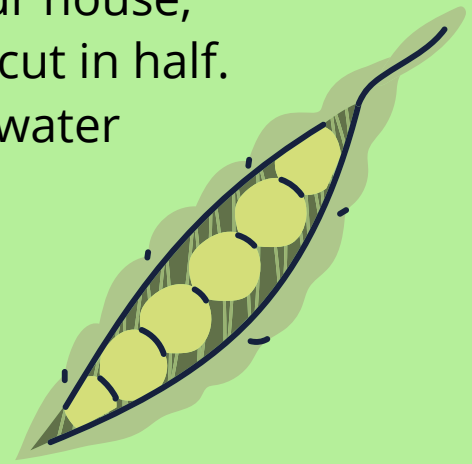
A Beginner's Guide to Gardening

What you will need:

1. Containers- re-use something from your house, example: egg cartons or a clean milk jug, cut in half. Make sure it has holes for draining extra water
2. Soil- provided
3. Popsicle sticks- provided
4. Marker- choose your favorite color
5. Seed Packets- provided
6. Water
7. Plastic Wrap



How to Start:

1. Fill your containers with soil.
2. Water the soil until it is damp. (watering afterward might upset the seeds.)
3. Plant your seeds in the soil. Look at the pictures on the back of this paper to learn which seeds you have!
4. Write the name of the seed on a popsicle stick, place in the soil in the container.
5. Cover your containers with plastic wrap to keep the soil humid, which means warm and damp.



Now What?

Zucchini



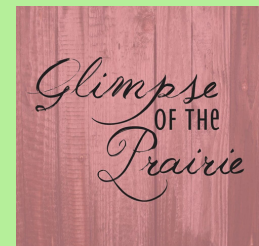
1. Observe (which means watch) and wait!
2. Which seeds do you think will sprout first?
3. How long do you think it will take for your seeds to sprout?
4. After the seeds sprout, remove the plastic covering and put your containers in the sunshine, but don't let them get sunburn.
5. Don't forget to water your seeds when the soil feels dry to the touch.
6. Once your plants are large enough, and it is warm enough, you can plant your seedlings outside!
7. Continue to water and care for your plants, watch them grow and then get ready to harvest your produce!
