## **“PLANT TREES” by Contributing to the Trees for North Dakota Trust Fund**

North Dakotans can help plant trees by making a donation to the Trees for North Dakota Trust Fund on their individual income tax returns. The North Dakota Forest Service provides grants to communities to help plant trees adapted to North Dakota’s climate. Adapted, diverse trees reduce the impacts of invasive insects, such as the emerald ash borer (EAB), which attacks and kills all species of ash trees and is as close as Minnesota.

Your donation can make a difference. Please enter your voluntary contribution on the 2015 North Dakota Individual Income Tax Return. On the ND-1, look for Line 31 on the *Refund Return*, and Line 35 on the *Tax Due Return*. On the ND-EZ, use Line 5 on the *Refund Return*, or Line 8 on the *Tax Due Return*.
