It has smooth awns, short rachilla hairs, and its intended uses are for malting and feed. Celebration is moderately susceptible to Spot-form Net Blotch, moderately resistant/resistant to Spot Blotch, and moderately susceptible/ susceptible to Net Blotch. All foundation class seed is produced by ND Foundation Seedstocks and seed must be obtained through the ND County Crop Improvement Association seed increase program.
