**Pinnacle** barley was released in 2007. Pinnacle is a two-rowed barley. It has smooth awns, long rachilla hairs, and its intended uses are for malting and feed. This variety has high yield, low protein, plump kernels, and strong straw strength. Pinnacle is susceptible to Spot-form Net Blotch, moderately resistant to Spot Blotch, and moderately susceptible to Net Blotch.
