

Comments

Stellar-ND barley was released in 2005 and is widely adapted to the Upper Midwest and Northern Great Plains. Stellar-ND is a six-rowed barley. It has smooth awns, long rachilla hairs, and its intended uses are for malting and feed. Stellar-ND has superior straw strength and high yield potential. This variety is moderately susceptible to Spot-form Net Blotch, moderately resistant/resistant to Spot Blotch, and moderately susceptible/susceptible to Net Blotch.
