


Avalanche

Navy Bean



Characteristics

Plant Type	upright short vine
BCMV	resistant
Rust	moderately resistant ¹
Maturity	medium-early
Canning Quality ²	acceptable

¹ Susceptible to new rust race 20-4.

Comments

Avalanche navy bean was released in 2008. It is a medium-early maturing variety with very good seed size, shape, and appearance. Avalanche has white flowers and dark green leaf color. It is erect (Type II, short vine) with good lodging resistance. This variety exhibits good synchronous plant dry-down prior to harvest and has good canning qualities. Avalanche is resistant to Zn soil deficiency and bean common mosaic virus (BCMV). It is also moderately resistant to most rust races present in ND.

Strengths

- Good synchronous dry-down
- Zn soil deficiency resistance
