


Lariat

Pinto Bean



Characteristics

Plant Type	upright short vine
BCMV	resistant
Rust	resistant ¹
Maturity	medium-late
Canning Quality ²	acceptable

Comments

Lariat pinto bean was released in 2007. This high yielding variety has excellent seed quality and very good lodging resistance. Lariat has an upright growth habit and also has synchronous dry-down of plant and pods at harvest. Lariat is resistant to rust, bean common mosaic virus (BCMV), and anthracnose race 7. It is susceptible to anthracnose race 73. The seed size of Lariat is very uniform and is slightly larger and of similar appearance to Maverick.

Strengths

- Upright growth habit
- High yield
- Good synchronous dry-down
