#### **Comments**

**Elgin-ND** hard red spring wheat was released in 2012 and performs well in both eastern and western ND. It has relatively high protein, especially for a variety with such high yield potential. Milling and baking qualities of Elgin-ND are very good. Elgin-ND also has a good disease resistance package including resistance to prevalent leaf and stem rusts, including some level of protection to the new leaf rust race Lr21.
