Types of roots

- Bare-root
- Containerized
- Ball and Burlap







Bare-Root

- Keep Roots Wet
- Dig the Hole

2 - 3 times the diameter of the roots

Not too deep

- Proper Depth
 - Find the Root Flare
 - Just under the surface
- Back Filling
 - Do not pack soil



Bare-root

- Water
 - Couple of Buckets
- Staking
 - Important
 - 2 stakes, 3 or 4 for Larger trees
 - Straight up and down
 - Remove after 1 full growing season

Mulching

- o 3-4 ft. around tree
- 2-4 inches from base of tree
- 4-6 inches deep



Containerized/Potted

- Dig Hole
 - 2-3 times root diameter
- Remove Container
 - Cut Roots
 - Find Root Flare
- Continue Same as Bare-root



Ball and Burlapped

- Dig Hole
 - 2-3 times root diameter
- Remove Wire Basket and Burlap
 - Cut Roots
 - Find Root Flare
- Continue Same as Bare-root



First Full Growing Season

- Don't just plant and walk away
- Water
 - Weekly, depending on conditions
 - Slowly Saturate
- Initial Trimming
 - Broken or Crossing Limbs
- Remove Stakes
 - After one full growing season
