4-H Members and Volunteers May Re-enroll in 4honine Beginning September 2.

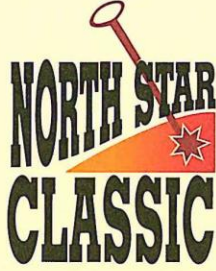
The North Dakota 4-H year starts September 1 and enrollment may begin on September 2. If you have been a North Dakota 4-H member, following these steps to re-enroll for the new year.

- 1) Go to: <https://nd.4honline.com>
- 2) If you were a North Dakota 4-H member, you already have an account. Click on "I have a profile"
Your login is your email address. (If you have more than one email, be sure you are using the same email which you provided to the County Extension Office.
- 3) Enter your email and password, your role is family, click on Login. (If you do not remember your password, click on: "I forgot my password" and a temporary password will be sent to you email.)
- 4) When you Login, a screen like this will appear. "Click on Continue to Family"

- 5) In your family, all enrolled members and volunteers will be listed. Your enrollment status will say Inactive (All accounts turn to Inactive at midnight August 31). Find the member or volunteer's name and click on Edit.
- 6) Review and correct or add information as appropriate. Click Continue. You must agree to and accept statements for Assumption of Risk and Release, Medical Authorization, Participant Expectation and Code of Conduct, and Privacy Statement Authorization in order to join the 4-H program. In addition, you will give or not give permission to a media release statement.
- 7) Click Continue, check the club in which you are enrolled. If correct, click on the Project tab. Select a project, and if you wish to order project material, select the publication and click on Add Project. The project has been added when it appears on the bottom of the frame. You may delete projects listed if you are not taking another year of that project.
- 8) Click on Submit Enrollment. County staff will review and approve your enrollment or let you know if something needs to be changed. The next time you log-in, your enrollment status will be Active.

Dear 4-H, FFA or NDJPSA members,

On behalf of the Livestock Committee of the North Dakota Winter Show, in Valley City, I would like to invite you to attend our state's largest cattle show, the "North Star Classic", which also features cattle sales, youth contests, a fitting clinic and more. This year's event is scheduled for Friday, December 2nd, through Sunday, December 4th. As you may know, the "Fairest of Them All" Show, was a new show that was added to the schedule last year. The show will again be held this year and is scheduled for noon, on Saturday, December 3rd.

There will however, be some changes to this show, with general information as follows:

- **Open to junior exhibitors of an Overall Grand Champion Heifer from any ND fair, Achievement Days or ND Junior Point Show, in 2016**
- No entry fee or bedding fee and the heifer may also be entered into the open show and/or junior breed show, by paying the respective entry fees. These additional shows would be optional only and not a requirement for the heifers to be shown in the "Fairest of Them All" Show
- Premiums will be: Grand \$750 ~ Reserve \$500 ~ 3rd \$300 ~ 4th \$200 ~ 5th \$100
- Enter by submitting an entry form, listing the fair name and title earned; late entries will not be accepted for this show. A total of 10 head must be pre-registered by November 11th, for the show to be held during the North Star Classic
