



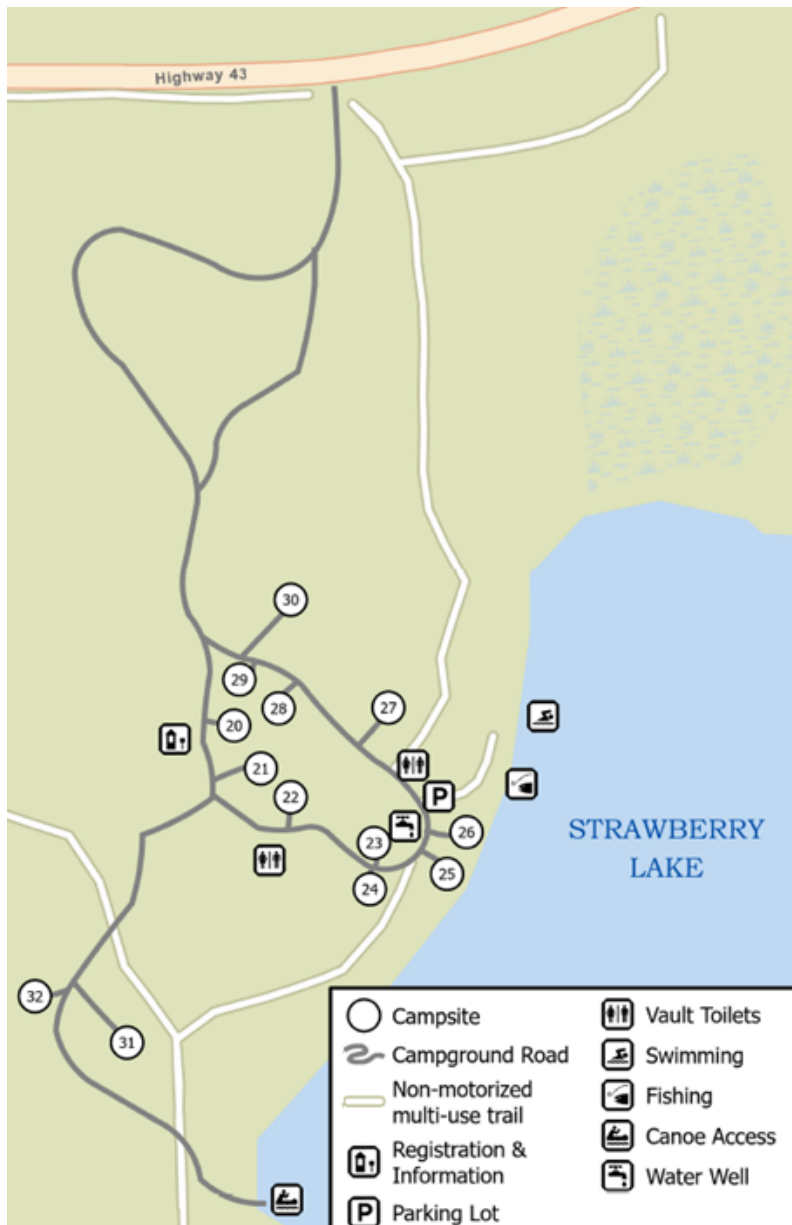

CAMPGROUND INFORMATION

CAMPSITES are primitive and first-come, first serve with a fee of \$15.00/ night.

FIREWOOD is provided with paid registration to utilize locally sourced wood and to prevent the spread of invasive species from outside wood sources.

QUIET HOURS are from 11 p.m. - 6 a.m.

FISHING for Rainbow Trout is available by utilizing fishing pier or kayak/canoe launch area.

TRAIL ACCESS to 18 mile trail system for non-motorized multi-use including hiking, biking, horseback riding, hunting, bird watching, and collecting berries.

PETS are welcome but must be on leash or controlled at all times. Owners must clean up after pets.

SHOOTING is NOT permitted within 800 feet of campground.

WINTER ACTIVITIES

ICE FISHING access is maintained all winter.

SNOWMOBILING is another way to experience the Turtle Mountain Region. A portion of the 177 mile Peace Garden Trail system goes along Strawberry Lake.

SNOWSHOEING and cross country skiing are common ways to experience the untouched areas of the 18 mile trail system.
