1. The Kidder County Fair Association Youth Livestock Point Show is a sanctioned member of the 2018 North Dakota Junior Association Point Show for Beef, Sheep, Swine and Goats. The show is open to all youth, 4-H, FFA and NDJPSA members residing in the state of ND. Exhibitors must have reached their 8th birthday and be no older than 21 as of October 1, 2018.
2. Each exhibitor must show their own animal unless he/she is showing more than one animal in the same class. Animals must be owned by the exhibitor or actively involved in the long term daily care of the animal. **Showmen with registered animals must present registration papers at the time of check in or the animals must be shown in the commercial division. All sheep and goats are required to have the official USDA Scrapie Identification Tag.** All market animals, sheep and swine must be tagged or tattooed.
3. **Out-of-state exhibitors of all livestock must show CVI (done within 30 days of show) to registration officials BEFORE animals are unloaded.** All out-of-state swine shown must have a CVI within 30 days and be individually identified with a tag as required by the State Board of Animal Health. All in-state swine exhibitors are NOT required to provide a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) or statement of health for this show.
4. There will be no showmanship classes held this year for any species.
5. There is no gate entrance fee. Early entries must be postmarked by Monday, July 5, 2019. The appropriate early and late entry fees are listed on the entry form and must accompany the entry form. **All entry monies will be returned to the winners in the form of premiums and plaques. PREMIUMS WILL HAVE ADDED MONEY.** Animals may begin arriving after 8:00 p.m. on Friday, July 12, 2019, and must be on the fairgrounds by 8:00 a.m. Saturday, July 13, 2019. All animals must remain on the fairgrounds until after all the shows are complete. **Exhibitors are released after they are done showing and their stall area is clean and inspected by a member of the Fair Association. Departure without a stall inspection will result in premiums being forfeited.** Exhibitors must supply their own bedding.
6. Registration and weigh-in of market animals will begin at 7:00 a.m. on Saturday, July 13, 2019. Judging of the swine will begin at 9:00 a.m. Show order for the rest of the day will be announced at the beginning of the show.
7. IAFE (International Association of Fairs & Expositions) National Code of Ethics will be followed. This is located in the ND State Fair 4-H Exhibit List book. All exhibitors in any event at the livestock show will at all times conduct themselves with honor, honesty and good sportsmanship. Those who violate the National Code of Show Ring Ethics will forfeit premiums, awards and be prohibited from future exhibition.

Kidder County Fair Association has the right to combine or cancel classes in any division.

Beef Market Steers:

The classes will be split according to weight. Weigh-in will begin at 7:00 a.m. on Saturday July 13, 2019.

Overall Reserve Champion Steer: \$150.00

Beef Heifers:

Only yearling heifers will be shown. No cow/calf pairs or heifer calves will be shown. Heifers will be shown by breed.

Classes will be determined by age depending on the number of entries.

Premiums: Classes: 1st: \$35.00, 2nd: \$25.00, 3rd: \$15.00

Breed Champions will be recognized

Market Sheep:

The classes will be split by sex and weight. Weigh-in will begin at 7:00 a.m. on Saturday July 13, 2019.

Breeding Sheep:

Three classes per breed of breeding sheep will be shown: Spring Ewe Lamb born January 1, 2019 or later, Yearling Ewe Lamb born September 1, 2017–July 31, 2018, and Fall Ewe Lamb born August 1, 2018 – December 31, 2018.

Premiums: Classes: 1st: \$20.00, 2nd: \$15.00, 3rd: \$10.00

Market Swine:

The classes will be split by purebred, commercial, sex and weight. Weigh-in will begin at 7:00 a.m. on Saturday July 13, 2019.

Dairy Cattle:

All breeds will be shown together. Two classes will be shown. The classes will be split on the basis of females that have freshened and females who have not freshened. On the basis of a large entry of dairy breeds, classes may be split by breed and age.

Market Goats:

All breeds will be shown together. Wethers and does will be shown separately and the classes will be split by weight.

Weigh-in will begin at 7:00 a.m. on Saturday July 13, 2019.

Breeding Goats:

Four classes divided into three age groups per class will be shown. Classes are: 1. Meat Doe – Full Blood/Purebred 2. Meat Doe - Percentage 3. Meat Doe - Commercial 4. Dairy Doe. Age groups are: A. Junior (under 12 months), B. Yearling (12-24 months), C. Senior (24 months plus).
