Youth Sheep Starter Flock Program

For the 12th year, NDSU Extension and the North Dakota Lamb and Wool Producers Association are offering North Dakota youth an opportunity to become involved in the sheep industry and build their own flock. Youth chosen for the Starter Flock Discounted Loan Program will receive an interest-free loan to purchase 10 yearling Rambouillet ewes from the association. attendance, you must submit a request to your local Extension Agent for a "one-time blanket authorization." The request needs to include that you intend to resume in-person meetings following Phase II guidelines. It will be helpful if you provide the normal meeting dates/time/location and include all meetings of your group for the remainder of the 4-H year, ending August 31, 2020.

- Proper social distancing must be implemented
- Use of face coverings for face to face interactions with a distance less than 6' between individuals is strongly encouraged
- Face to face programming targeted for at risk and other vulnerable populations is not allowed (e.g. target audience over age 65, target audience with underlying health conditions)
- An attendance record for all activities must be kept in order to facilitate trace back in the event of a positive case.

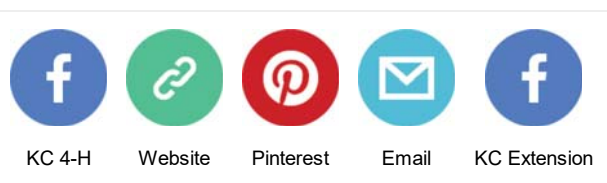
