

# Contest Categories

- **Sew & Wear** (formerly Sew & Show): Garments that are sewn.
- **Buy & Wear** (formerly Buy & Show): Purchased garments
- **Decorate & Wear** (formerly Decorate Your Duds): Embellishing a garment
- **Make & Wear**: Garments that have been crocheted, knitted, etc.
- **Make & Show**: Non-wearable items that can be sewn, crocheted, knitted, etc.

Examples—Tote Bag, Purse, Zippered Pouch, Quilt, Knitted Slippers

# Age Divisions

**Teen:** Age 13 & older as of Sept 1, 2016

**Preteen:** Age 8-12 as of Sept 1, 2016

**Cloverbud:** Age 5-7 as of Sept 1, 2016 (**ONLY** eligible to participate non-competitively at the county level.)

1. You must be enrolled in a Clothing & Textiles or Fiber Arts Project.
2. One entry per category, but you can participate in as many categories as you want at the county contest.
3. Those receiving blue ribbons can only participate in two categories at the State Fair.
4. Make & Wear and Make & Show are not eligible for State Fair at this time.
