All scholarship application forms are due at the McLean County Extension Office, PO Box 1108, Washburn, ND 58577 on **May 15**.

This scholarship is available for 4-H members.

Eligibility for the McLean County Scholarship:

Candidates must be:

- A high school senior.
- A current 4-H member.
- Been involved in the 4-H program for at least 5 years.

Information Required as Part of Your Application

To be considered as a scholarship candidate, you must include the following items in your application:

- The scholarship application form – this must be completely filled out, with all required signatures. A word processor or computer may be used to complete the application. Please type or print using black ink. For attachments, use plain white 8 ½ x 11 paper.
- Letter of recommendation – This letter must be from someone other than a relative, example would be a teacher, coach, 4-H leader, church leader.
