2021 4-H Achievement Days



In order to participate in the 4-H Achievement Days Premium Sale, 4-H'ers **must** have completed the following criteria in the current 4-H year:

1. Participate in Achievement Days Set-Up AND Tear-Down

(If you are unable to attend set-up or tear-down you need to contact the Extension Office (628-2835) prior to Achievement Days. They will assign a job for you to do to meet your criteria.)

2. Meet all 4-H membership & animal ownership deadlines and requirements.

3. Turn in your Livestock Project Record to Static Judges.

4. Attend eight club meetings OR activities (not counting #1 or #3 above)

Possible activities are listed on the back of this form. **NOTE:** You must be an **active participant** in the activity/event – attending the activity/event does not meet the criteria.

- Participate in **Mountrail County Home & Garden Show**
- Participate in the **4-H Pet Show (Stanley)**

- **Exhibit in the Static area** at Achievement Days (only use if you are exhibiting in 2021 Ach. Days)
- **Exhibit in the Livestock area** at Achievement Days (only use if you are exhibiting in 2021 Ach. Days)
- Attended **4-H Awards Day** in 2020
- Participate on a **Judging Team** (all workouts together count as 1 activity)
- Participate at a **Judging Contest** (each contest counts as 1 activity)
 - Examples, livestock, hippology, crops, etc
- Compete in an **Open Livestock Show** other than Achievement Days.
 - Example, Upper Missouri Fair counts as 1, Flaxton show counts as 1, etc
- Attend a **2021 4-H Camp** of any type or be registered for one after Ach. Days (each camp counts as 1 activity)
- Attend **Extension Youth Conference (EYC)** in Fargo
- Participate in a **Community Service Project** (each project counts as 1)
- Participate in **4-H Clothing Revue/Communication Arts/Clothing Revue or Consumer Decision Making, or Rube Goldberg** (County = 1 activity, State = 1 activity)
- Participate in a **Science & Technology Event** (Aerospace, Robotics, etc.)
- Participate in **4-H Activity Day** in Minot
- Attend County **YQCA training**
- Attend a **National 4-H Event**
- **Mountrail County 4-H Ambassador** (each meeting counts as 1 activity)
- Participate in any **other special Mountrail County 4-H event not listed**
 - Virtual opportunities are included in this
- Participate in any **other special State 4-H event not listed**
 - Virtual opportunities are included in this
