The North Dakota 4-H Film Festival will be held on Sunday, July 19, 2015 beginning at 1 p.m. during the ND State Fair in Minot. 4-H members ages 11 to 18 are encouraged to create and submit a video. Teams of one to four members may submit a film, and at least one of the team members must be a current 4-H member. A \$100 cash prize will be awarded to the top entry in each division and a \$100 cash prize will be given as the People's Choice award. Your video, registration form and required paperwork need to be to Linda Hauge at the State 4-H Office by June 19th.

North Dakota 4-H Camp Counselor/Intern Search

Former 4-H'ers or other young adults are encouraged to apply for this opportunity to be a summer camp counselor at the North Dakota 4-H Camp in Washburn, ND. Staff must be at least 18 years of age.

Responsibilities include assisting in the development and implementation of research-based educational programming in camping and youth development while working under the supervision of the 4-H State Youth Specialist and ND 4-H camp chairs. Qualifications for the internship include the completion of at least two university semesters of undergraduate coursework (achieved at least a sophomore status by the 2015 fall semester). There will be up to three NDSU Extension Camp Counselor/Intern positions available during the summer of 2015. There will be a total of four counselor positions at camp this summer. The state ND 4-H Ambassadors' purpose is to assist in planning statewide 4-H youth programs, to promote 4-H, and to improve the 4-H program through problem solving skills and leadership. As a 4-H Ambassador, youth are responsible with assisting the 4-H program around the state. Some activities include (but are not limited to): assisting at county events, at the ND State Fair, Selections, and Extension Youth Conference. Ambassador retreats are held four times a year.
