

Livestock Criteria for Premium Sale

2012 4-H Achievement Days

In order to participate in the 4-H Achievement Days Premium Sale, 4-H'ers must have completed the following criteria in the current 4-H year.

1. Participate in Achievement Days Set-Up AND Tear-Down

(If you are unable to attend set-up or tear-down you need to contact the Extension Office (628-2835) prior to Achievement Days. They will assign a job for you to do to meet your criteria.)

2. Turn in your Livestock Project Record

3. Attend eight club meetings OR activities (not counting #1 or #2 above)

Possible activities are listed on the back of this form. **NOTE:** You must be an **active participant** in the activity/event – attending the activity/event does not meet the criteria.

 - Examples, livestock, hippology, crops, consumer choices, etc.
- Attend a **Livestock Workshop**.
- Compete in an **Open Livestock Show** other than Achievement Days.
 - Example, Upper Missouri Fair counts as 1, Flaxton show counts as 1, etc.
- Attend a **4-H Camp** of any type.
- Attend **Extension Youth Conference (EYC)** in Fargo.
- Participate in a **Community Service Project** (each project counts as 1).
- Participate in **4-H Showcase** (county = 1 activity, state = 1 activity).
- Applied for **Year End Awards** in 2010.
- Attend **4-H Awards Day** activity.
- **Exhibit in the Static Area** at Achievement Days.
- Participate in the **4-H Pet Show**.
- Attend a county **4-H Council Meeting**.
- **Volunteer as a Youth Leader** in your club or another club.
- **Volunteer Helper** for the 4-H After-School program.
- Participate in **Shooting Sports Training** (all training sessions together count as 1 activity).
- Participate in a **Shooting Sports Competition** (each competition counts as 1 activity).
- Participate in **Horse Fun Nights** (all fun nights together count as 1 activity).
- Participate in the **County 4-H Horse Show**.
- Participate in an **Open Horse Show** (each show counts as 1 activity).
- Participate in **Consumer Choices** at county, district or state (each level counts as 1 activity).
- Participate in **Leathercraft Work Day**.
- Participate in **Log Furniture Work Day**.
- Participate in **Cloverbud Workshop**.
- Participate in **Technology Day Camp**.
- Participate in **Farm Safety Awareness Program**.
- Participate in **Sewing Workshop**.
- Participate in a **Science & Technology Event**.
