Program Overview

PROGRAM PURPOSE To stimulate the development of innovative and effective community forestry

program development projects.

ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS Public entities that own or control the land where the project will be located must

submit the application.

FUNDS AVAILABLE A public entity is eligible to receive a maximum grant award of \$10,000.*

Bids or price quotes will be required for successful applicants. Grant funds will be distributed on a reimbursement basis.

MATCH REQUIREMENTS A grant request may not exceed 50% of the total project cost.

At least 50% of the total cost of the project must be contributed by the applicant

from sources other than federal funds, in the form of cash and/or in-kind

contributions.

APPLICATION DEADLINE April 30, 2014. No faxed or emailed applications will be accepted.

Applications postmarked <u>after</u> April 30 will <u>not</u> be accepted.
