

North Dakota Statewide Windbreak Renovation Initiative 2.0



2022 Grant Application – Information & Instructions Application Deadline September 30, 2022

Applicants read the following information BEFORE applying for a windbreak renovation grant.

Refer to your Windbreak Assessment (site visit) Report when filling out the application. Your report has been developed in coordination with ND Forest Service and includes a summary of the windbreak condition, discussion of renovation options, and representative photos.

If you have not had a Windbreak Assessment (site visit) Report completed for your windbreak, do not apply for a renovation grant at this time.

Review this timeline:

June 20, 2022 – grant application pool opens

August 31, 2022 – last day to request a site visit for the 2022 grant application pool

September 30, 2022 – application deadline; 2022 application pool closes

Approximately* October 15, 2022 – Successful applicants will be notified and will be emailed an agreement to sign to accept their grant award. NDFS uses DocuSign for contracts, which requires a valid email address. Agreement must be signed within 14 days. After 14 days, the agreement will be **VOID** and the grant award will be rescinded.

Once the Agreement is signed by the applicant and the State Forester, the renovation project can begin.

DO NOT START THE RENOVATION WITHOUT A SIGNED AGREEMENT.

What you will need to complete the Application:

- 1. Windbreak Assessment (site visit) Report.
- 2. The name and contact information of the technical assistance partner who will be assisting with the project.
- 3. Approved ND-CPA4 Tree and Shrub Planting plan, if there will be machine replanting.
- 4. List of conservation grade trees and shrubs that will be used if there will be hand planting.
- 5. Cost estimates for practices that will be cash expenses. Written estimates are not required but are recommended.
- 6. Aerial image showing all practices included in the application, and the amount (acres, feet, etc.) for each practice.
