



North Dakota Forest Service Summer Employment Opportunity

The North Dakota Forest Service is currently seeking summer interns/seasonal employees for the 2016 field season.

Location: Bottineau, ND

Period of Employment: Summer season 2016, start and end date negotiable, up to 6 months.

Duties:

- Work hours are generally 40 hours per week, 8 hours per day. Occasional work on weekends may be required.
- Employee may perform varied duties, work under general supervision and may be required to make independent decisions relevant to performance of work tasks.
- Employee must be able to work outdoors in varying conditions.
- Driver's license required.
- Ability to use a GPS unit and upload GPS data onto a computer preferred. Ability to locate landscape features on aerial photos preferred.
- Ability to identify common trees and shrubs of the upper Midwest.
- Knowledge in the use of forest inventory equipment such as: diameter tape, compass, increment corer.
- Ability to identify North Dakota listed noxious weeds
- Experience operating lawn equipment and pruning tools preferred; Experience hauling trailers preferred.

Compensation: \$10.00 per hour. **Basic housing will be provided.** Enrolled students may negotiate receiving credits with a major professor in the case of an internship.
