New this Year: "Brisket Battle", OPEN TO THE PUBLIC, Brisket and "FULL MEAL DEAL", Tickets can be purchased at the door.

OBJECTIVE: 1. Promote commercial cattle. 2. Promote economic development in the cattle industry. 3. Obtain carcass data for the producer. 4. Work as a source to keep everyone informed about the cattle industry & ways to improve economic value for cattle enterprises.

Rules: 1. Two pen limit per family. 2. Calves must weigh between 500-700 lbs Weights above or below the limit can be fed at the research center, but are not eligible for the contest. 3. Pens include 3 or 4 steers per pen. Pens of 3 or 4 will be judged excluding sale calves. 4. Purebred breeders promoting their breed must enter a pen of steers or sponsor someone and then they may exhibit their livestock. 5. Carcass show includes the top 3 steers of a registered producer, (if a pen of 4 and a sale calf are entered, DFCS will correlate the top 3 calves of the registered producer into the carcass contest, excluding sale calves).

Health Requirements: Vaccinations, preferably 3 weeks prior to show: BVD, PI3, IRB & BRSV; Pasteurella; 7-way with Haemophilus. All other vaccination and etc. will be done at registration.

Other Issues: NO HORNS; NO FRESH CASTRATIONS; NO RAT-TAILS; NO CLIPPING OR WASHING; OPEN TO ALL BREEDS AND CROSS-BREEDS; NO DAIRY BREEDS; NO HEIFERS.

Sale calf auction: 1. No additional registration. 2. Sale is between the buyer & seller with the the option for no-sale. 3. Calves will be fed with the other contest steers but will have a separate jackpot prize of \$500; \$300 to the winner (buyer) and \$200 to the producer (seller). 4. Contest based on the same criteria as other steers. 5. To enter the sale, you will enter 1 extra steer per pen with a 2 steer limit. 6. DFCS will select the steer for auction. 7. If the breeder buys back his calf, it will be considered a no-sale, which eliminates the calf from the contest. 8. Early postmark entries will be prioritized for the 160 head contest limit if necessary. PRODUCERS ARE ENCOURAGED TO BRING CATTLE EARLY THE DAY OF THE SHOW OR THE DAY BEFORE, AS THE CATTLE MUST BE WORKED BY 11:30 AM THE DAY OF THE SHOW.
