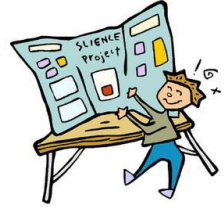


SHOWCASE

The 4-H Showcase consists of Clothing Revue and Project Expo. Project Expo is simply a table top display of the project of your choice. It is scheduled for **Saturday, May 6th at the MLS-Mohall School**. This is done in conjunction with the 5th Grade Basketball Tournament scheduled for Mohall on the same day - we planned it that way. If you are both playing and involved in the 4-H activity you may be kind of busy that morning, but don't worry, we will work around your ballgame schedules. Hopefully you will be able to be judged when you have the time to catch your breath in between one of your games. I have assured the MLS administrators that the basketball schedule will be your first priority. We will waive the dress code for basketball players. We will set up in the Multi-Purpose Area of the school. Set up will be scheduled for 9:30 – 10 am, with the judging beginning at 10:00.



A tabletop display is a neatly decorated table with examples of your finished product, and either examples or a description of what you did to complete this project. The judge looks at your display and asks you questions about your project. You can use "title" posters, "summary" posters, "ingredient" posters, etc. Keep in mind, you do not "demonstrate" your project. Please fill out the attached registration sheet by **April 20th to pre-register**. Remember, **the dress code will be enforced (except ball players) for Project Expo!**

The Clothing Revue is open to anyone currently involved in a sewing project or Clothing Decisions project. If you plan to participate in the Clothing Revue, there is a brief narrative I will have you fill out for your project. Again we would like to stress **pre-registration by April 20**.

There is available a new updated bulletin for Showcase. If you would like a copy please let me know. Also keep in mind that the state Project Expo contest during the state fair is now open to an unlimited number of exhibitors, but first you must participate at the county level. Also keep in mind for the County Contest it is requested that you bring your own card table.

Cloverbuds! At Project Expo we will ask Cloverbuds to participate with their Cloverbud recitation of the 4-H Club Pledge or the Pledge of Allegiance. They need not pre-register. They are not critiqued and they have the option of doing their recitations as a group and/or by themselves.
