Cost: **\$5.00** per participant (includes lunch, snack, and all 4 activity sessions) This can be paid on the day of event.

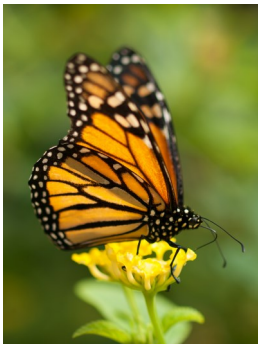
Participants will be divided into four groups with a group leader. The groups will do each 55 minute activity during the day. There will be 10 minute breaks between sessions.
