- **Drive up to the west door to bring in exhibits, then park back on the east side.** The back room on the west side of the barn will be the “volunteer/parent room” this year. Use the west stairway or elevator to take exhibits for judging or put them in the “volunteer/parent room”. After judging, volunteer runners will take the exhibits down the east stairway to be displayed downstairs.
- Volunteers are needed to be “runners” (2 per shift) to take judged exhibits downstairs. This will allow the 4-H’ers to keep judging without interruption.
- Small children should be supervised by parent or adult. There will be lawn games set up outside. Concessions will be available Friday and Saturday. The 4-H Council will provide 4-H members with meal coupons.

- Only 4-H’ers exhibiting are allowed in exhibit area—Joan Beyer, monitor and Kayla Bakewell, Exhibit Agent, will be available if anyone needs help or has questions. Parents may help first-time exhibitors.
- Each club will be responsible to fill **six** shifts (3 per shift, if possible) for judge’s assistants. (Shifts are 12:30-2:30 or 2:30-4:00.) For first shift instructions, please arrive at 12:15. This can be a **4-H member, parent, grandparent, sibling, etc.**
