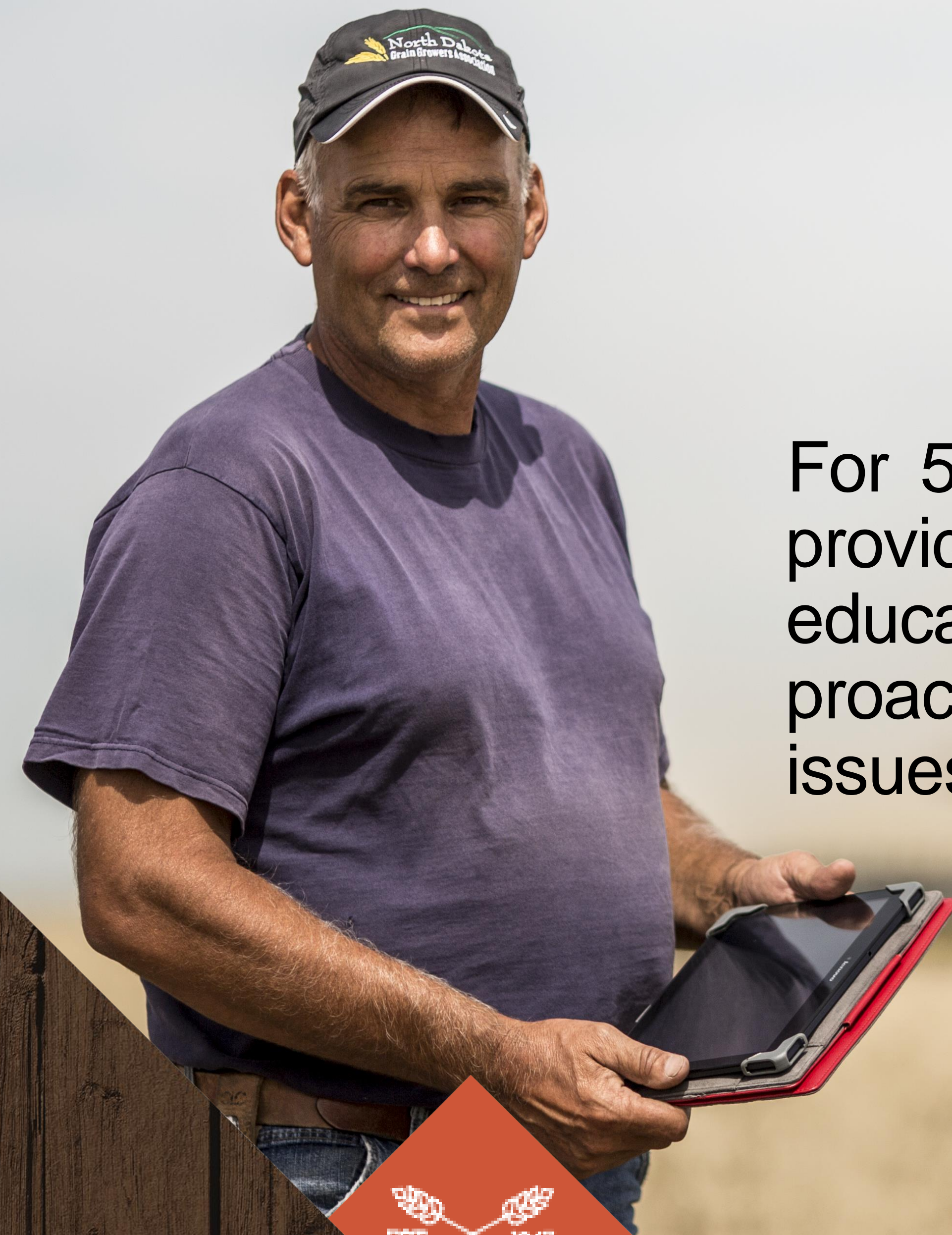

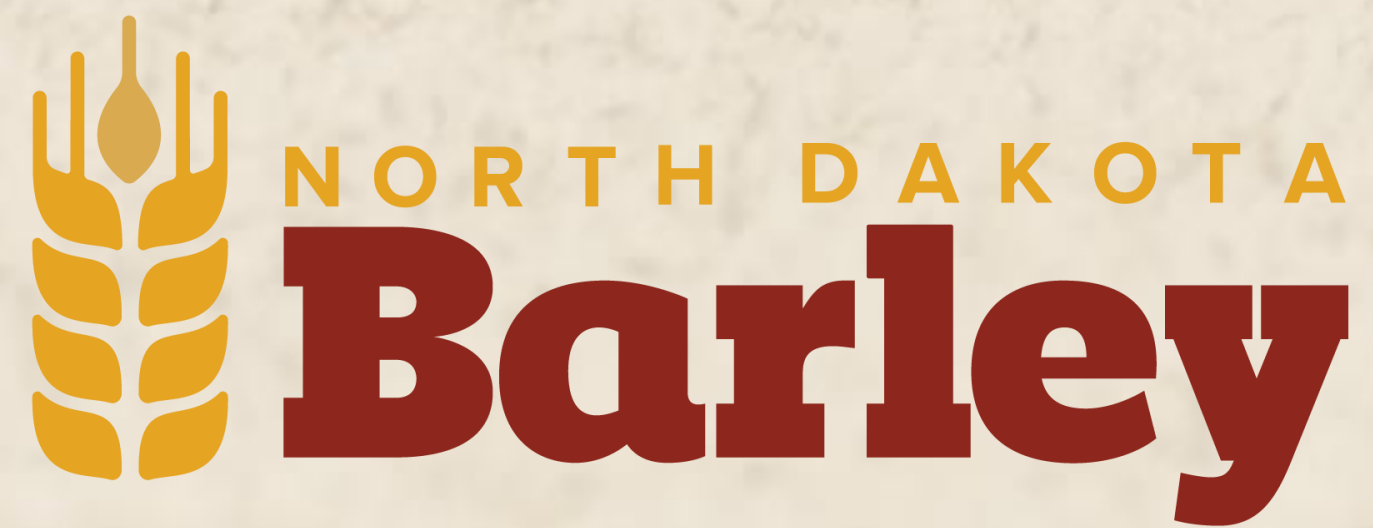




NDGGA

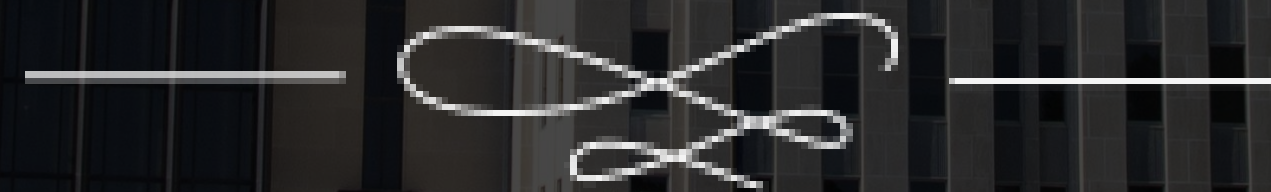

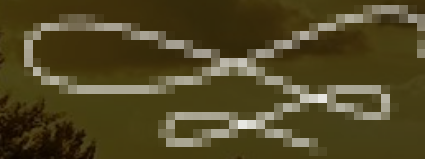

EPA calls it the “gold standard” of tours.

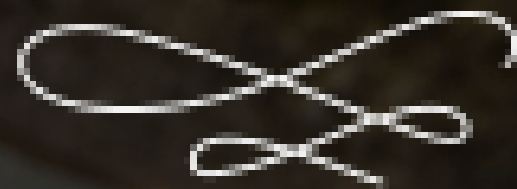
