**MATCH** - cash or in-kind (volunteer labor, services, donated supplies, use of equipment)

**GRANT Deadline:** April 30, 2019

**Eligible applicants:** Public entities with legal ownership or control of land where project is located (counties, townships, cities, park districts, school districts, tribal equivalents)

### Grant Application Tips

- Do a soil test to match tree species to site
- Plant a diversity of tree species
- Get assistance from resource professionals
- Earn EXTRA POINTS by using ND Tip Tool to plan the project
- Provide photos of project site and a planting design plan
- Check the math on project budget page
- Submit ORIGINAL application and 7 copies (8 TOTAL)

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
