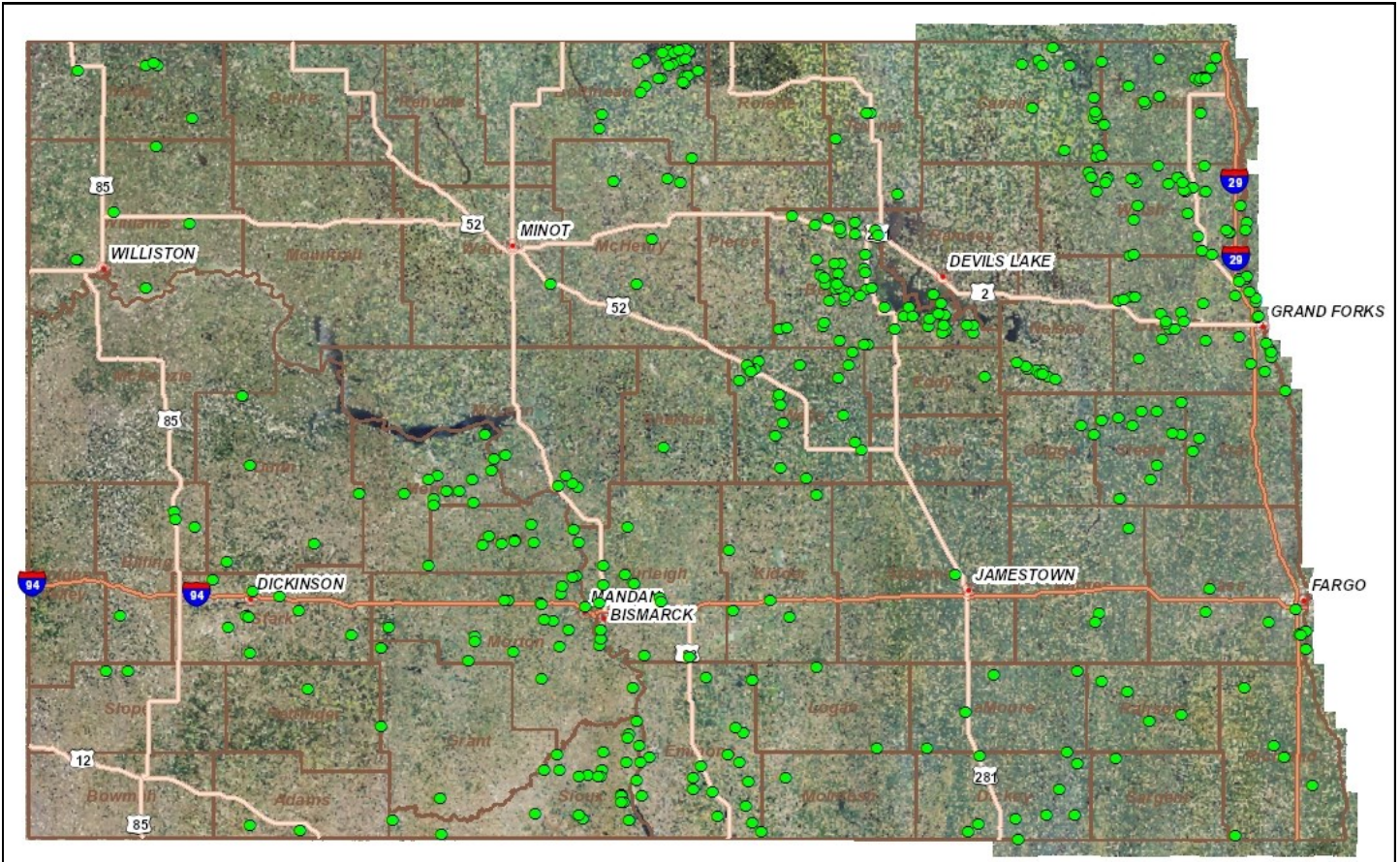

As of December 2013, 433 privately owned forests in North Dakota were being managed under Forest Stewardship Plans.

The Forest Stewardship Program offers a free, no obligation, written Forest Stewardship Plan to private landowners. These ten-year plans, developed by forest resource professionals, are designed to help the landowner better understand their forest and manage the forest to meet their individual goals, for the benefit of the landowner as well and the resource.
