**New Business-**

Stutsman County Fair - Robin Barnes gave an update on what the livestock committee has planned and that the NDSU State office has different regulations than what North Dakota has. Plan A is to have the livestock shows the week of June 22<sup>nd</sup>, Plan B is July 6-8 and Plan C is virtual shows. Livestock have butcher dates and pasture dates that need to be kept, so they were limited as to when to hold the shows. We are currently limited to a maximum of 10 people gathering in an event. The hope is that there will be an adjustment of that number before plan A of the livestock committee's, and that there will be a greater lifting before we have the horse show.

Show dates and Judges: With the understanding that everything is uncertain, three dates were chosen as possible show dates, along with 3 judges. Robin will check with the Fair Board to see if these dates are open, check with the judge to see which works and we will work toward that goal.
