Call to Order – Robin Barnes called the May 27, 2020 meeting to order.

Old Business

County Contests 2.0 – Current NDSU Extension guidelines are to stay within 10 people face-to-face or less to help mitigate Covid-19.

- Clothing Revue (CR) and Communication Arts (CA)** – Discussion was held on potential dates, location, management of exhibitors/contestants, exhibitors/contestants needed, and the registration process. Christina Rittenbach has prepared a draft clothing revue registration process in Google Docs/Forms. Bonnie Hofmann made a **MOTION:** That the Clothing Revue (CR) be **June 14, 2020** at 4pm and Consumer Decision Making (CDM) be **June 14, 2020** at 1pm at the Stutsman County Fairgrounds with a minimum of three exhibitors/contestants for each contest. Martha Bjorgaard seconded the motion. Motion carried. Bonnie Hofmann made a **MOTION:** That registration be made for Clothing Revue (CR) and Consumer Decision Making (CDM) by Google Docs/Forms emailed to 4-H organizational leaders to forward and by links posted on the Stutsman County 4-H website and Facebook page. Ann Marks seconded the motion. Bonnie Hofmann **AMENDED the MOTION:** To include the registration of

Communication Arts (CA) and Project Expo (PE). Ann Marks seconded the amendment. Motion as amended carried.

- B. **Communication Arts (CA) and Project Expo (PE)** – Discussion was held on possible date, location, management of exhibitors/contestants, and exhibitors/contestants needed. It is noted there would be no physical awards ceremony, but options would be monitored for future recognition. There will be a virtual state contest for each county for CDM on July 21st. Bonnie Hofmann made a **MOTION**: That the Communication Arts (CA) and Project Expo (PE) be **June 28, 2020** at 1pm at the Stutsman County Fairgrounds with a minimum of three exhibitors/contestants. Ann Marks seconded the motion, motion carried.
- C. **Static Exhibits** – Discussion was held on dates, location and management of static exhibitors. It is unknown at this time if there will be premium monies. Ann Marks made a **MOTION**: That the Static Exhibit contest be **August 6, 2020** at the Stutsman County Fairgrounds with live judging as usual. If group guidelines aren't lifted by July 31, 2020 then all static exhibits will be exhibited with absentee entry forms. Bonnie Hofmann seconded the motion. Motion carried. The fair registration deadline for static exhibits will be extended to July 16th. The registration for animals remains June 8th.
