January 30, 2018

No formal meeting due to lack of attendance

Tiffiney Dick and Robin Barnes were present for the meeting. Robin did not call for order, but she and Tiffiney went over the agenda and made several decisions from the questions that Robin had about the upcoming Communication Arts/Project Expo event. Here are the highlights.

1. T-shirts for the Cloverbuds - we will give one t-shirt to every Cloverbud who is competing that day, not one shirt for each event.
2. The high point award for Communication Arts will be a choice of a coat, vest, or duffle bag. Points will be the total of all the scores for that speaker. Cash awards for each event will be the same as last year. Money for the accounts are flush.
3. DQ gift cards will again be purchased for the judges and helpers.
4. I will contact the judges from last year to see if they would again be able to judge - thinking that they will have some experience as to the style and requirements now. I also have notified Toastmasters of the event and asked that they let me know if they would be interested in judging. I am also going to talk to the Farmers Union office - both to check out the facility and to see if they have any that would be interested in judging.
5. March 1st is the entry deadline - entries will be mailed out either Feb 2 or Feb 5.
6. Consumer Decision Making (formerly Consumer Choices) and Clothing Revue is set for May 6th. We need to meet for that soon, also. **LET ME KNOW WHEN YOU THINK WE SHOULD MEET - MUST BE BEFORE MARCH 15TH**. Tiffiney would like to start some consumer practice sessions and I said I would ask if Alicia or Christina would be able to set some times up. I may be gone for this event, but Alicia and Christina will be here.
7. Next year we host the regional communication arts contest - going to see if the FU building will work with us for this event. I would also like to have you think about hosting a consumer decision making meet where we invite other counties to bring in teams - just like other judging contests. Just an idea!
