

North Dakota Tree Selector

Oak, Mongolian - *Quercus mongolica*

A medium to large tree forming an open, somewhat irregular crown at maturity. Native to eastern Asia. Growth and performance in NDSU trials are similar to Bur Oak. Rosy to coppery fall leaf color often occurs and leaves are retained into early or mid-winter. The largest tree in North Dakota is 26 feet tall with a canopy spread of 28 feet.
