The Ward County Shootout will be held at the North Dakota State Fairgrounds in Minot on Friday, June 19th, 2020.



- It is a non-profit, multispecies livestock show
- Held after the Ward County 4-H Achievement Days
- Considered part of the North Dakota Junior Point Show Association state-wide shows where kids accumulate points to earn year-end prizes
- Kids do not have to be members of the points system to participate
- Participants are all under the age of 21
- Doughnuts and drinks will be provided Friday morning

My name is Rhonda Korgel and I voluntarily run the Ward County Shootout with help from the Ward County 4-H office. Ward County kids and their animals that participate in 4-H Achievement Days are able to show their small species and beef projects one more time. This gives the Ward County kids a chance to show against some of the toughest competition in North Dakota and meet kids who have the same interests.

The 2019 Ward County Shootout went off with a bang. We had 150 families from 3 states showing 100 head of show cattle and 150 of sheep, swine, and goats. We were able to award \$7,500 in cash prizes, with \$3,500 staying with the Ward County kids. *We hope you decide to stay and participate in the Ward County Shootout.*

Unfortunately the North Dakota Junior Beef Expo on June 20 has been cancelled. If Ward County 4-H Achievement Days (June 15-18) is cancelled, the June 19 Ward County Shootout is cancelled.
