Tractor safety is a very important part of the Wells County 4-H Tractor Driving Contest. For 4-Hers to be safe drivers, adequate training, age, size and ability are all important.

The policy adopted by the Wells County 4-H Council states that all participants must pre-register and have parental permission.

The tractor driving contest will have the following divisions: BY September 1st of the current 4-H year.

- (1) Beginners – 9-10 years old BY September 1st of the current 4-H year.
- (2) Juniors – 11-13 years old BY September 1st of the current 4-H year.
- (3) Seniors – 14-18 years old BY September 1st of the current 4-H year.

MUST HAVE EXPERIENCE IN DRIVING A LAWN TRACTOR OR YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE. THIS WILL BE LEFT TO THE DISCRETION OF THE COMMITTEE. Juniors must be able to find where to add oil, and id the parking brake.

Will be required to drive a course set up by the committee.

Ribbons given: Blue, Red or White. Grand and Reserve will be chosen from those completing the course following all safety rules. Time will be used as a tie breaker if needed.
